SUMMARY OF EVENT - SUSTAINABILITY

Sustainability is a broad concept, with the need to embed principles of sustainability in all that we do.

At Hyder's recent seminar 'Being Sensible about Sustainability', we discussed these issues and the fact that government is beginning to introduce a range of legislation that is designed to bring about a culture change in organisations to deliver its sustainability targets. While this is focussed on climate change and the need to reduce carbon emissions, the outcome will be the same - lower costs and the chance to differentiate an organisation based on sustainability performance.

Achieving these outcomes is relatively simple, requiring an organisation to identify and focus on the issues, have a clear strategy on how its targets will be met and then set out organisation wide and local action plans describing what will be done on the ground to achieve the desired outcomes.
